Next: 2nd empire. Study in the order: Dan.8 - 7 - 2. Next: 3rd empire (Greek) order: Dan.8 - 7 - 2. Then: 4th empire (Rome) order: Dan.8- 2- 7- back to 8. The Roman papal identity of the little horn of Dan.7 (supposed) is thus confirmed by Dan.8.</p>
<p>Empire Chaldean of Babylon (605 BC – 539 BC) 1st king: Nebuchadnezzar (or Nebuchadnezzar II)</p>	<p>V. 38-37: King Nebuchadnezzar, thou art this head of gold, ... the God of the heavens gave thou strength (= lion: Judges 14:18) the empire (= eagle) the dominion over men and birds of the sky (= eagle)</p>	<p>V.3-4: came up of the great sea, an animal like a lion with wings of eagle its wings were torn off; a man's heart was given to him, he was put on his feet like a man. (king's dominion withdrawn and returned: Dan.4)</p>	
<p>Empire of the Medes and Persians (550 BC – 333 BC)</p>	<p>V.32: His chest and arms were silver. V. 39: After thou will rise a kingdom less than thee.</p>	<p>V.5: And behold, a second animal, a bear stood on one side (Persian dominion over the Medes) he had three ribs in his mouth, between his teeth. (= conquests) First rib Second rib Third rib</p>	<p>V.3: I looked, and behold, a ram stood before the river, which had two horns, but one was higher than the other. V.4: And I saw the ram pushing westward and northward and southward</p> <p>V.20: The ram that thou sawest ... They are the kings of the Medes and Persians. = Persia (546 BC). = Media (614 BC). = conquest of Babylon (539 BC). = conquest of Lydia (546 BC). = conquest of Egypt (525 BC).</p>
<p>Greek Empire (333 BC – 323 BC) Greek kingdoms (323 BC – 146 BC) In 301 BC the empire is divided into four kingdoms</p>	<p>V.32: His belly and thighs were of bronze. (bronze = sin: impure alloy) V. 39: then a third kingdom, which will be of bronze, and which shall rule over all the earth.</p>	<p>V.6: After that, another was like a leopard (leopard = sin: Jer.13:23), and had on his back four wings like a bird, and he had four heads. 1st head = Ptolémée 1st Sôter 2nd head = Seleucos 1st Nikatôr 3rd head = Cassandre 4th head = Lysimacos</p>	<p>V.5: Behold, came from the west a he-goat. Without touching his surface, (=flying) he traveled all over the earth. V.8: His great horn broke, and to the four winds of the heaven, four great horns rose up to replace it, (he-goat = animal type of sin: Lev.16:5-34 - Matt.25:33)</p> <p>V.21: The he-goat is the king of Javan (= Greece) ... the great horn between his eyes is the first king. = death of Alexander (-323). = universal character (= 4 winds). = Lagide dynasty (Egypt). = Seleucid dynasty (Syria). = Greek kingdom. = Kingdom of Thrace.</p>
<p>Monarchical Rome (753 BC) Republican Rome (510 BC) Roman empire (27 BC – AD 395) Ten peoples of Western Europe, remained under Roman papal authority (538-1798), and until ...</p>	<p>V.33: His legs were iron V.40: ... a fourth kingdom strong as iron, he will tread and break everything. V.33: His feet and ten toes were clay and iron. V.43: will make human alliances but will not be united.</p>	<p>V. 7: Then a terrible animal and extraordinarily strong. He had big iron teeth. He broke, trampled, what was left. he had ten horns. V.8: Another little horn came up of their midst. V.24: and he shall be different from the first.</p>	<p>V.9: From one of them came a little horn which is growing a lot towards to the south to the east and to the most beautiful country. V.10: It rose to the army of heaven ; and it cast down of the army and stars to the ground ... V.25: He will rise up against the Chief of the chiefs, but he will be broken without any hand.</p> <p>= Republican Rome rises to imperial status Victory and domination over: = Carthage (- 400 - 250) = Greece = one of them (-146). = Israel (- 63 = Syria conquered by General Pompey). The loop is closed Towards the birth of J.-C., Rome becomes the iron legs of the fourth empire of Dan.2. In Dan.7, the return of the little horn will concern papal Rome.</p>
