PARALLEL MESSAGES BETWEEN DANIEL 7 AND DANIEL 8

DAN. 7:8	- man's eyes - says <mark>arrogant</mark> words.	=	DAN. 8:25	- have arrogance in the heart. (= Babylon : $Dan.5:20 = 4:30$).
7:24	- is an eleventh king different from the first ten. (= religious reign)	=	8:23	- impudent and artificial king (= false spiritual claim).
7:25	- will hope to change times and the Law . (law = truth: Ps.119:142).	=	8:12	- cast the truth on the ground (= modified Ten Commandments).
	- oppress the saints of the Most High. (= stars: Dan.12:3)	=	8:10	- made the army of the heavens and the stars fall and fall (see Gen.1:17).
	- the saints will be delivered into his hands for a time, (two) times, and half a time.	=	8:12	- The army was given with the perpetual because of the sin .

ADDITIONAL MESSAGES FROM DANIEL 8 AND DANIEL 11

- DAN. 8:11 ... rose to the Chief of the army, took away from him the perpetual

 (perpetual = intransmissible priesthood of Jesus: Heb.7:24)

 8:24 its power vill increase, but not by its own strength.

 See the summary of the study of Dan.11 structure on Chart 3

 = DAN. 8:25 will rise against the Chief of the chiefs ...(King of kings and Lord of lords = God: 1Tim.6:15)

 = 8:25 because of his prosperity and the success of his wiles (= spiritual threats against kings and the rulers of the earth).
 - 11:36 The king will do what he will want, will glory himself above all the gods (here the Roman papacy relays the Greek king of Syria Antiochos IV).
 - 11:37 will have no regard to any god, nor to the god of his fathers (= abandonment of the pagan gods: can no longer concern Antiochos IV worshiper of Jupiter), nor to the divinity which is the object of the desire of women (= allusion to Priapus, sexual god of virility of Roman orgies, suggested papal piety).
 - 11:38 but will honor the god of the fortresses ... with gold, silver, precious stones ... (= wealth of cathedrals and catholic churches).
 - 11:31 He will honor those who recognize him, he will make them dominate over many, he will give them land for reward. (= allusion to the spiritual and temporal power, imperial and royal seals of the Roman popes).
